September 14th Program The Scots In Early America

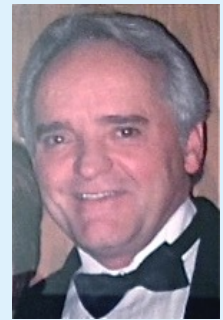
